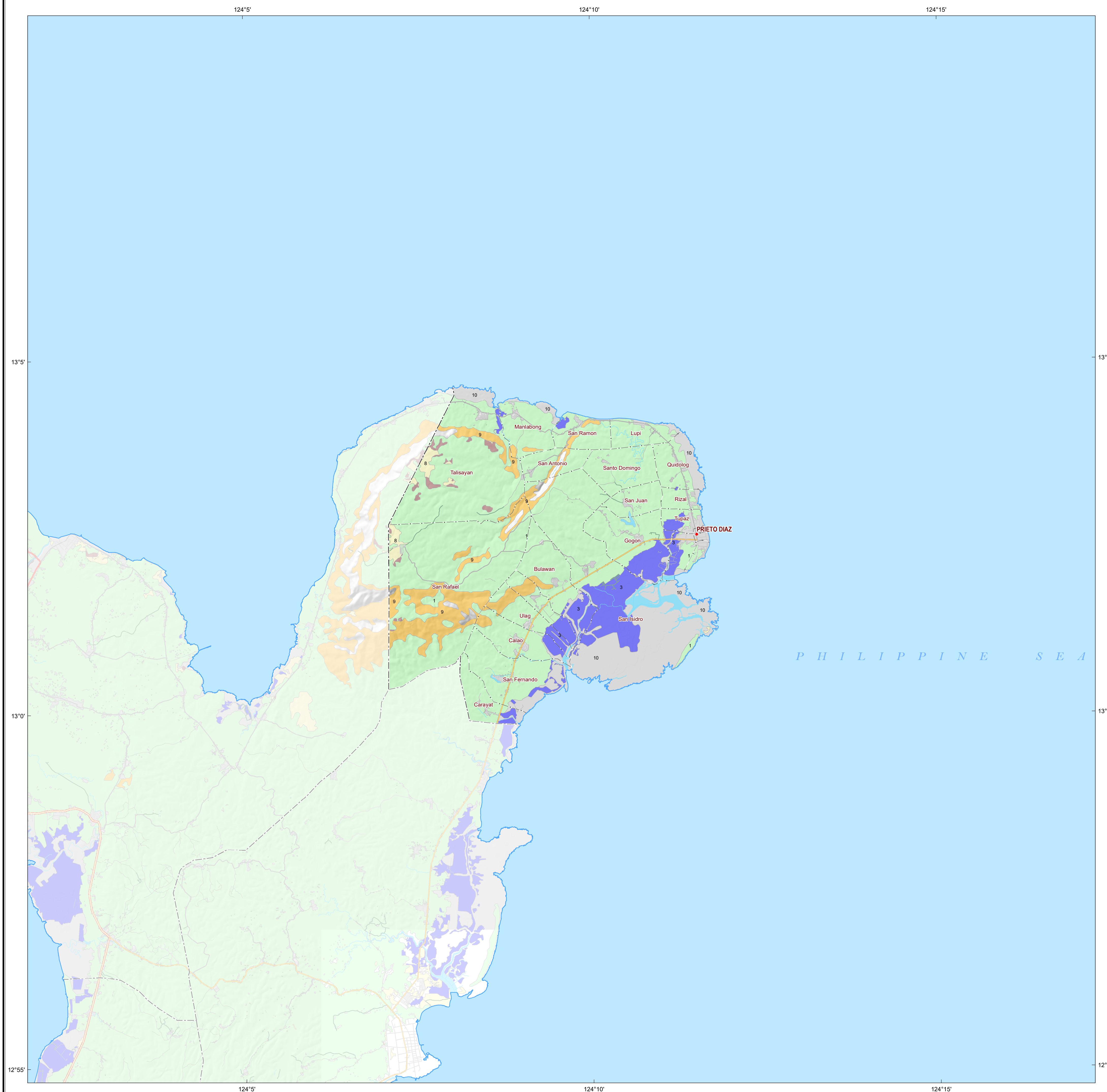

Land Resources Information and NPAAAD/SAFDZ from the Agricultural Land Management and Evaluation Division (ALMED) and Soils Survey Division (SSD). Land Use/Vegetation Cover are obtained from the Land Use System (FAO, 2015), Philippine Rice Information System (PRISM) (RHR, 2015) OpenStreetMap (OSM) and Satellite Images from Google. The slope and aspect are generated from SRTM-30-meter spatial resolution.
