Subdivide the Lot further or allow submission of bids on a regional basis:</p>	<p>Reiteration of the following Bid Bulletins:</p> <p><b>Bid Bulletin No. 3: Procurement of Supply and Delivery of 3,247 units of Technology Package on Composting Facility for Biodegradable Wastes for CY 2023- IB NO: BSWM-2023-07-045”</b> provides that:</p> <p><i>“Per the Government Procurement Policy Board (GPPB), the Procuring Entity’s (PE) is in the best position to determine its needs, including the procurement strategy to be employed to address needs.</i></p> <p><i>Considering the conducted market study, the lots were divided into four (4) based on geographical proximity or clustering, hence will help in the timely accomplishment of the PE’s physical and financial targets.”</i></p> <p><b>Bid Bulletin No. 1: Re-Bid of Lot 2 under the Procurement of Supply and Delivery of Technology Package on Composting Facility for Biodegradable Wastes for CY 2023- IB NO: BSWM-2023-08-048</b></p> <p>Retain the provision under Section II Clause 19.4 of the bidding document:</p> <p><b>One Project having several items, which shall be awarded as one contract.</b></p>

Decrease the total numbers of required availability of stocks for assembled and raw materials:</p>	<p>With reference to the <b>Bid Bulletin No. 3: Procurement of Supply and Delivery of 3,247 units of Technology Package on Composting Facility for Biodegradable Wastes for CY 2023- IB NO: BSWM-2023-07-045”</b> that provide that:</p> <p><i>“Minimum requirement:  10% assembled, 90% raw materials of first delivery target”</i></p> <p>To ensure achieving programmed physical targets as submitted to DBM and DA, minimum requirement for availability of stocks is 10% assembled and 90% raw materials of the total delivery for the 4th quarter of CY 2023.</p> <p>November to December 2023 delivery  Region 5 = 240 units</p>



	<p>10% assembled = 24 units 90% raw materials = 216</p> <p>IMPORTANT: <b>Submit as part of your technical proposal an EXECUTION PLAN for the whole contract (capacity to produce per week) that the bidder can complete the delivery as scheduled.</b></p>
<p><b>3. Acceptance of SLCC that is not Fabricated/ Manufactured:</b></p>	<p>RA 9184 Section 23.4.1.3 states that:</p> <p><i>"The bidder must have completed, within the period specified in the Invitation to Bid, <b>an SLCC that is similar to the contract to be bid.</b> xxx " (emphasis added)</i></p> <p><b>One of the major specifications of the project being procured is that it shall be locally fabricated as stated in Section VII of the bidding document.</b></p> <p>Reiteration of the following Bid Bulletin:</p> <p><b>Bid Bulletin No. 1: Re-Bid of Lot 2 under the Procurement of Supply and Delivery of Technology Package on Composting Facility for Biodegradable Wastes for CY 2023- IB NO: BSWM-2023-08-048</b></p> <p>Retain the provision under Section III Clause 5.3 of the bidding document:</p> <p><b>For SLCC: Contract on Supply and Delivery of Manufactured/ Fabricated Agricultural Processing Equipment/Agricultural Machineries and/or Solid Waste Management Equipment.</b></p>
<p><b>4. To remove the requirement of NAMDAC and BAFE Permit to Operate as Manufacturer/ Fabricator.</b></p>	<p>Reiteration of the following Bid Bulletin:</p> <p>Bid Bulletin No. 3 of the procurement project "<b>Procurement of Supply and Delivery of 3,247 units of Technology Package on Composting Facility for Biodegradable Wastes for CY 2023- IB NO: BSWM-2023-07-045</b>" provides that:</p> <p>Bidder shall have a valid NAMDAC and BAFE Certificate as manufacturer/ <b>fabricator.</b></p> <p>Based on experience, End-User had issues with dealers, especially in terms of conduct of training and after sales service. Since they have no company personnel knowledgeable on the technology package (detailed mechanism of the machine), dealers tend to redirect concerns to their source manufacturer who is not part of the contract. This results in delays in the provision of technical assistance to the beneficiaries.</p> <p><b>Joint Venture Agreement may be entered into per RA 9184.</b></p>
<p><b>5. Set the1 date of delivery requirement for the whole contract</b></p>	<p><b>Amended Section VI. Schedule of Requirement</b></p> <p><b>Completion of delivery shall be on or before May 30, 2024, to wit:</b></p> <p><b>November to December 2023</b> <b>Region 5 = 240 units</b></p> <p><b>January to May 30, 2024:</b> <b>NCR = 10 units</b> <b>Region 4A= 198</b> <b>Region 4B= 247</b></p> <p><b>Note: Schedule of delivery per Region for January to May 2024 delivery (NCR, Regions 4A and 4B) will be finalized with the End-user during contract implementation.</b></p>
