Also, knowing the socio-economic factors affecting the adoption of these conservation practices is vital to provide useful inputs to policy makers and planning officers in their future efforts to develop effective enforcement strategies for the sustainable adoption of soil and water conservation measures in the highlands of Bukidnon. It is also significant to consider the importance of these conservation practices to sustain food production and protect the environment while contributing to the UN's Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) Nos. 1 (No Poverty), 2 (Zero Hunger), 13 (Climate Change), 15 (Life on Land) and 17 (Partnerships for the Goals).
